Gospel Reading: Lk 10:21-24

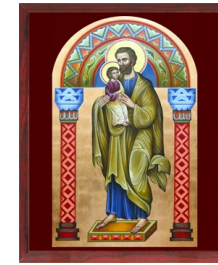
Gospel:

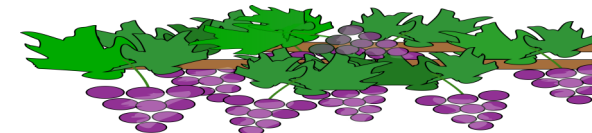
