Gospel Reading: Mt 28:16-20

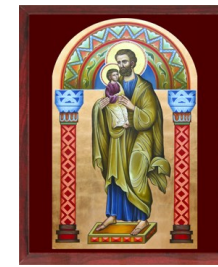
Gospel:
