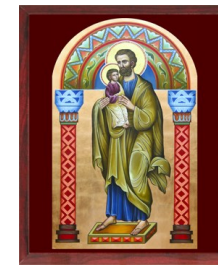
Gospel

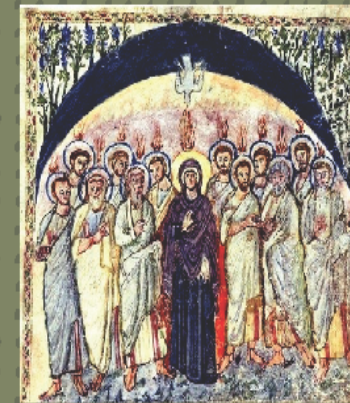
