This is the truth. Peace be with you



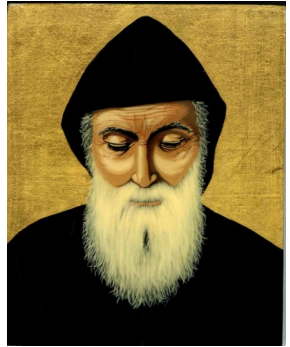

Head Start Rental Update

We are pleased to announce so good news for a change! We renegotiated our Lease Agreement with Head Start for the rental of the school building for another 5 years. After going back and forth a bit, we were able to have them agree to a **5.4%** annual increase beginning next year, which amounts to **\$4,600.00** more each year starting with our current (2024) base amount of \$85,000.00. This increased amount annually should not only help us with paying the bills for all of our facilities, but hopefully we will have a bit left over to re-invest in the school building, to make necessary repairs and improvements. *Fr.
