This is the truth! Peace be with you!

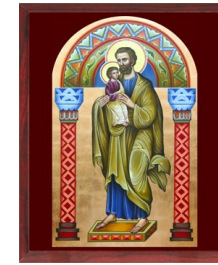

Grape Leaves Needed

June is the best month for picking grape leaves. We will need grape leaves for our Lebanese Dinner on August 3, 2025. If you would like to help, please:

1. Pick the grape leaves (preferably the large ones)
2. Clean them
3. Dry them
4. Stack them and count them
5. Wrap in saran wrap & foil or place them in a zip lock bag
6. Label the amount with permanent marker
7. Freeze them
8. Bring them to the church; we can store them in the kitchen Freezer
