Stay in the same house and eat and drink what is offered to you, for the laborer deserves his payment. Do not move about from one house to another.”

- 2. Clean them**
- 3. Dry them**
- 4. Stack them and count them**
- 5. Wrap in saran wrap & foil or place the zip lock bag**
- 6. Label the amount with permanent marker**
- 7. Freeze them**
- 8. Bring them to the church; we can store them in the kitchen Freezer**
